ROB PARKINSON: FEES FOR PUBLIC VENUES 2007

***The following are guide fees. All prices are negotiable.
See separate lists for school & library fees & training days.***

1. Larger theatre and arts centres, halls etc, with over one hundred seats/places. Also larger festivals:

Full length performances from £350

Performance with separate workshop from £400

Two performances from £500 (can be one for children, one for adults)

Travel costs may be added to basic fees by arrangement.

(Separate performances for children and adults on same day negotiable at similar rates.)

2. Smaller theatres and arts centres, halls etc. Also heritage sites, museums etc.,

smaller festivals: Depends on the funding position of the host. Minimum charge is usually £200, but I'm sympathetic. View School & library fees for a guide to normal costs for public venues involved in education outreach.

3. Community and voluntary groups, clubs, charities etc: Again depends on the funding position. For voluntary groups with small funds, performances, workshops and talks may be given for low charges, especially at low season times (school holiday periods especially, excluding Christmas weeks; also January, early May and all of

September). Organizations with good levels of funding can be guided by school prices (see separate School & Library fees download) with the possibility of good discounts.

4. For Talks and Speeches:

There is no set fee for talks and speeches since the circumstances in which they are given vary so widely. The range is usually between around £150 and £350, but organizations with very small budgets are welcome to get in touch to see what the possibilities might be.

5. Parties and private functions: It depends on where and when. The minimum is usually £90 for shorter sessions and £150 for full evenings where little travel is involved. Otherwise prices are from £100 and £200 plus travel. But ask anyway.

N.B. VAT is not charged. Payment is usually by cheque on the day of the engagement unless by prior arrangements. Deposits are not usually required but letters stating agreed terms and payment arrangements are.
